2019 "Write Out Loud" Rules

Western Colorado Writers' Forum

Submission Deadline: May 24, 2019

Creative work is being sought the Western Colorado Writers' Forum (WCWF) and KAFM Community Radio for use in two live theater events on Friday, June 28 and Saturday, June 29. Authors will have the option to read their work under the direction of Radio Theater producer, David Kenworthy. At least two rehearsals will be required. There will be readers available for those authors who choose not to read their chosen work. The theater production will be recorded as it is performed. KAFM and WCWF reserve the right to rebroadcast or post the work on air or on their web sites. The copyright is retained by the author. Audio copies will be made available to authors who want them.

Categories:

One Act Play:

1. Your play must fit a small stage with no scenery so please supply the setting with words in your play somehow. Remember the production will be live, but also become an audio tape, not a video so not much room for visual action or changes.
2. When formatting your play, we ask that you follow the [style here](#):

3. Your play must contain no more than four characters.
4. No more than two entries will be accepted from each playwright.
5. Keep your play under ten minutes in length. If your play is a Monologue, it can last no longer than five minutes.

What amazing things can you make happen in ten minutes?

Flash Fiction/Non-Fiction:

1. Your story must be no longer than 5 minutes.
2. When formatting your story, please use at least 12 point font with a margin of 1.5 inches on the left and double space your work.
3. Number the pages.
4. No more than two entries will be accepted from each author.

Poetry:

1. Poems must be no longer than a total of five minutes.

2. If submitting more than one poem, please submit them in a single document, but on separate pages.
3. No more than three poems will be accepted from each author:

General Guidelines:

1. Each entry must have a separate author page listing your name, address, phone, and e-mail. If the work has been previously published or produced, please list where and when.
2. Author's names must not appear on the work itself to assure impartiality of judging.
3. Work with multiple pages must include page numbers.
4. Works submitted electronically must contain the author's last name and title of the work in the document name.
5. Electronic submissions can be made at wcwritersforum@gmail.com.
6. Manual Submissions can be made or mailed to Western Colorado Writers' Forum, 740 Gunnison, Suite 205, Grand Junction, CO 81501
7. Any submissions must be the original work of the author. If the work has been previously published, submitter must have retained the copyright to the work.
8. If the work is chosen for broadcast, authors will be asked to provide proof of copyright if work has been published elsewhere.
9. Works will be judged by a panel for suitability for radio broadcast, creativity, and artistic quality.
10. Works selected for the Radio Theater should entertain and stimulate thought. Humor is entertaining.
11. Authors will have a chance to change/edit their works after each rehearsal.
12. Winner's names will be announced in all Western Colorado Writers' Forum platforms.
